Operating Policy / Procedure – League Registration

POLICY / PURPOSE STATEMENT

The Board of Directors of Long Beach Pony Baseball (LBPB) has adopted the following policy and procedure for registration of players for the regular season.

The LBPB Board of Directors is committed to ensure the best possible baseball experience for the members of our league. League Policies and Procedures have been established and agreed upon by a majority decision (vote), by the Board of Directors in accordance with the following:

- a. The best interest of the majority of the league
- b. The best interest of an individual (when it does not conflict with #1)
- c. The progressive direction and vision for the future of the league (when it does not conflict with #1 and #2).

This policy / procedure may only be amended by a majority vote of the LBPB Board of Directors prior to the start of the regular season.

I. REGISTRATION AND "WAITING LIST"

- A. To be "OFFICIALLY REGISTERED" forms must be submitted and monies deposited.
- B. Not more than fifteen (15) players shall be placed on a team.
- C. Registered players will be advised of wait list status once team capacity has been reached.
- D. To be placed on a waiting list, a player must be "OFFICIALLY REGISTERED".
- E. Managers must inform the Player Agent, of any players who have dropped or are no-shows. This must be done within two (2) weeks of the deficiency or disciplinary action can result.
- F. A waiting list will be maintained up to four (4) weeks from the beginning of the season. After that time, those on the waiting list should be contacted and a refund issued.

II. REFUNDS

A. Prior to the draft, a full refund may be made. After draft day, NO REFUNDS will be made.

III. SNACK SHACK

A. Parents will be required to volunteer in the snack shack. The Board Members on an annual basis will determine the number of required shifts. Parent(s) of each player will be required to pay a \$100.00 refundable, volunteer fee due at each team's, first parent meeting. Upon completion of all assigned shifts for that season, the parents will receive a full refund. If the parent(s) do not sign up or complete their shifts the fee is forfeited.
